Clean Water for Haiti and Africa!

FFCC has researched a new water purification system for both Haiti and Africa. This new filter system is simple, inexpensive, lightweight, and nearly goof proof. In addition, it is **less than 1/3 the cost of our previous system!** We can carry 70 of these systems with us in a single suitcase! Just think of the impact we can have installing these in 70 homes or more, each time we take a trip to Haiti or Africa.

Unsafe drinking water is a major cause of sickness and death in the third world. **The recent cases of cholera in Haiti are a direct result of drinking polluted water.**
