Why Tanzania?

Our Purpose in Tanzania – To help & assist the government and community leaders throughout Tanzania with sustainable solutions to food, water, health and educational needs.

- Provide drought resistant seed, food source and replanting for sustainability
- Provide SD packaged meals to subsidize food supply
- Construct the Children's Center in Manyoni. Model for expansion throughout Tanzania for food distribution
- Install water purification systems
- Install drip irrigation systems
- Equip and sustain Porta-Doc for medical provisions to remote villages in the Singida Region
- Develop relationship with local SD hospital and Singida hospital district
- Continued development of Gunda Secondary School
- Build housing for teachers and girls dormitory

June Trip Objectives

- Food distribution in Nkungi village
- Food distribution at Children's Center in Singida
- Seed and Food distribution to the Hadzabe tribe
- Tutoring of struggling students at the Gunda secondary school
- Visit and love on the children and babies living in the orphanages in Moshi
- Begin construction of the watchman's house at the water treatment system in Nkungi
- Continue the construction of the Children's Center in Manyoni

Trip Safety and Provisions

- Our 2 guides and brothers, live in Arusha and will be traveling with us to Singida and Nkungi
- We have a medical doctor, Naomi, living next to us
- The hospital is only minutes away in both Singida and Nkungi
- Our 6th trip, 72 that have gone, most have made it back. Some have made the trip 3, 4 and 5 times
- Tanzania has one of the highest tourism rates due to safari's and Mt. Kilimanjaro
- Safe housing, food, water and transportation

Cost of the Trip

- The cost of the trip will be \$4,000 dollars for the 1st 25 travelers who sign up
- Additional travelers **may** pay more based on airfare rates after the first 25 signee's
- An additional cost for the Safari will be approximately \$300 dollars
- \$500 non refundable deposit due by 12/31 – if flights are available
- 50% (\$2,000) due by March 27
- 75% (\$3,000) due by April 24
- 100% (4,000) due by May 15
